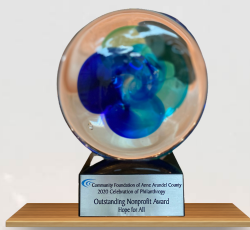

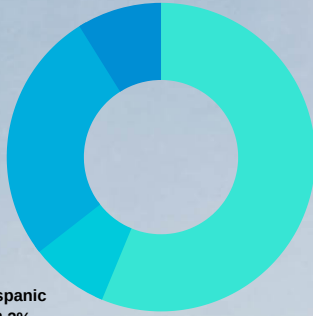

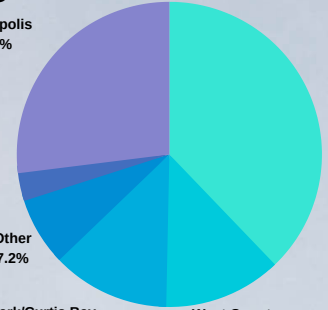

## Next Step Clothing

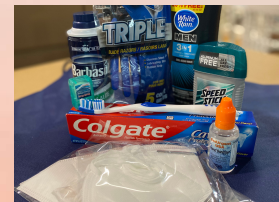


Provided clothing for **345 people** who were homeless, in recovery, placed in emergency care, leaving prison, disabled, and more.
